## RAVENNAMOSAICO 2015

The fourth International Contemporary Mosaic Festival RavennaMosaico takes place between 10 October and 8 November. The capital city of mosaics and the 2015 Italian Capital of Culture Ravenna will welcome works and artists from around the world.

RavennaMosaico international festival is organized by the City of Ravenna in collaboration with AIMC (International Association of Contemporary Mosaicists) and involves many cultural associations and institutions of the city. The two main exhibition halls of the 2015 festival are the MAR - Ravenna Art Museum and Palazzo Rasponi dalle Teste, a prestigious building that has recently reopened to the public.

The MAR museum will host the works selected for the third GAeM *Giovani Artisti e Mosaico* prize for young mosaic artists, as well as a documentary exhibition and tribute to the 20th anniversary from the creation of *La Chambre Turque* by Balthus, a mosaic signed by the author and currently on display at Expo Milan 2015.

A series of exhibitions and installations will be set up in the rooms of Palazzo Rasponi, such as the traditional *Works from the World* collection, a selection of over forty works by French, German, Lithuanian, Norwegian, Egyptian, Russian, Japanese and Israeli AIMC artists, as well as a homage to monumentality and lightness including a selection of works from France.

One of the common features to some exhibitions of this 2015 festival is the creation of collective works that combine the knowledge of different artists into a single work. This is the case of *A sea of mosaic* project by Officine Bizantine Riunite that, after being exhibited at Expo 2015, will be presented at Palazzo Rasponi, of *Signs* by the German Caroline Jung, and of the Dutch project *Social Sofa*. Several side events such as meetings, presentations and conferences will add to the programme of RavennaMosaico 2015, some of which included in an internationalization project supported by the Emilia-Romagna region with a special focus on Russia and Turkey.

In the last days of the festival, at the end of this biennial gathering of international mosaic artists in Ravenna, a monumental mosaic wave (*Mosaico dell'onda*) will be unveiled at the future Archaeological Museum of Classe as a tangible bridge between the ancient mosaic art and its contemporary forms.

Produced in the workshops of Professor Leonardo Pivi and Daniele Strada, these mosaic works are the result of various courses held at the Fine Arts Academy of Ravenna.

Food is the main theme of the "Nourishing the Mosaic" (*Nutrire il Mosaico*) project. The title also hints at the central role of the Academy for the innovation of contemporary mosaics and aims at being auspicious for the Mosaic School that has always played a decisive role in the revival of Ravenna's mosaic art.

Also on display, the ten finalist mosaic works of the Rotary Club Ravenna 2015 prize for the Academy dealing with the topic of art as food for thought.

## **BALTHUS IN RAVENNA**

The exhibition retraces the origin and implementation of *La chambre turque* by Balthus (Balthasar Klossowski de Rola), a mosaic adapted from the work of the same name painted between 1965 and 1966 and housed at the Centre Pompidou in Paris. *Balthus in Ravenna* consists of a detail of the mosaic work by Ines Morigi Berti and of about 40 pictures. It illustrates the design of the project - supported by Cristina and Riccardo Muti - as well as the various phases of the mosaic translation organized by Pro.Mo in 1995.

## **ROTO B. RECOVERING GOLD** **Mosaic work by Marco Bravura, 2008**

The intention behind this sculpture is to focus on the value of reuse and salvaging, learning the art of recycling-reuse-revaluation, including the reshaping of our way of seeing things. The idea originates from artist's observation of gold smalti scraps and wheat byproduct.

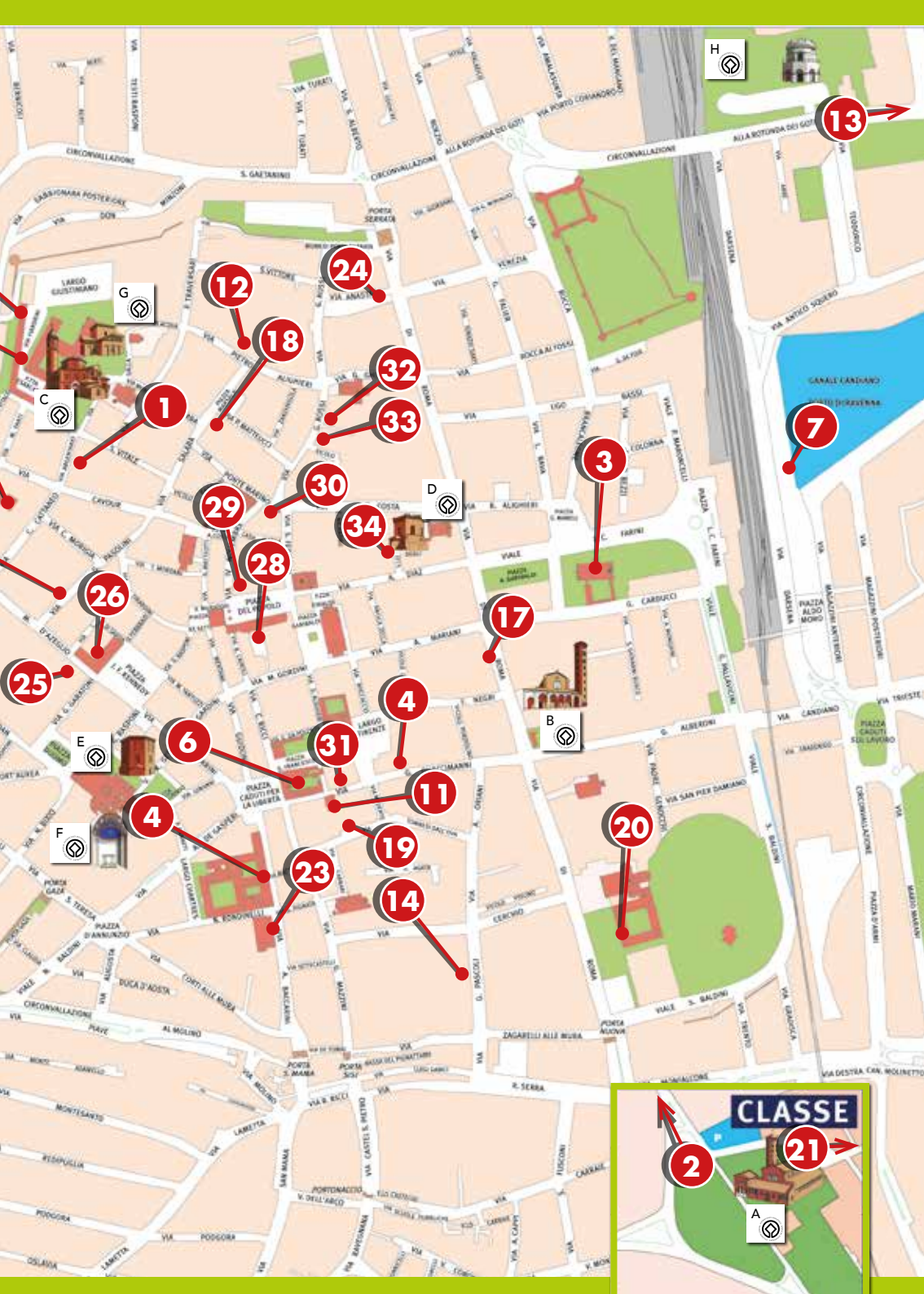
